Milt Sayler made the motion, seconded by Dan Sayler for a resolution for the Florence Township Zoning Commission Erie County, State of Ohio to post a notice to the public for organizational, informational and work session meetings on the Florence Township website (www.florencetwp.com) and also on the outside bulletin board of the Florence Township Office at 11011 Chapel Street, Wakeman, Ohio 44889.

Ms. Marsh opened the Zoning Commission work session and asked if anyone in the audience had any comments or concerns. Cheryl Watkins and Estelle Truscott voiced their concerns with the returning to the pyramid zoning. Ms. Marsh thanked them for their input.
