

**Florence Township Trustees
Regular Meeting Minutes
6-1-2016 8pm**

Trustees present: Orville Sayler & Skip Halliwell. Not present: John Krumwiede

The Florence Township Trustees held their regular meeting at the Florence Township Office Complex located at 11011 Chapel St., Wakeman, Ohio.

The meeting was opened with the pledge.

MOTION: Orville made the motion and it was seconded by Skip to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Roll call: all 'ayes. Motion approved.

Zoning

Zoning Board Commission approved the recommendation on the following at their public hearing on May 11th :

1) Truscott Estella D Trustee Etal, Parcel #07-00911.000, 15201 SR 60 Birmingham OH 44816

- a) Parcel #07-00911.500 (1 acre) Rezone from Industrial Manufacturing (I) to General Business (C-2)

2) Jessel Jon P & Dede L, Parcel #07-00073.000, SR 60 Wakeman OH 44889

- a) For zoning purposes only (Lot approximately .75 acres, west of South St.)—Rezone from Industrial Manufacturing (I) to General Business (C-1) Local Shopping District
- b) For zoning purposes only (Lot approximately 1.25 acres, south of Mickey Mart)--Rezone from Industrial Manufacturing (I) to General Business (C-1) Local Shopping District
- b) For zoning purposes only (Lot approximately 4.0 acres, east of Dollar General)-- Rezone from Industrial Manufacturing (I) to General Business (C-2)

MOTION: Motion was made by Orville and seconded by Skip to set the Trustees public hearing on the proposed changes for Wednesday, July 6th immediately following the 8pm regular meeting. Roll call: all 'ayes. Motion approved.

Trustee Reports

Trustees report the cemeteries looked good for Memorial Day parade. They thank the Rodger & Tom for their work.

Recycling bin in Florence has had ongoing problems –Bin not being removed on a regular schedule resulting in bags being “dumped “outside the bin. It gets scattered and the road crew spends hours cleaning up. This has been a problem since January. Skip has complained to the commissioners and Erie County Solid Waste Management several times.
